Evidence and information to be provided in the context of the eligibility assessment

After completion of the competition, the awarding authority will verify in the negotiating procedure whether the prize winners can guarantee the proper fulfilment and execution of the design submitted.

The minimum requirements must first be proven by the first prizewinner after the competition and before the contract negotiations.

In the negotiated procedure, the following minimum requirements are set with regard to legal, economic, financial and technical capacity (eligibility assessment):

1.) Chamber entry

Proof of qualification and permission to practise as an architect*in/urban planner*in/landscape architect*in (chamber entry).

2.) Proof of professional liability insurance

Professional liability insurance in accordance with § 45 para. 1 (no. 3) VgV / status 2016. Proof of the existing insurance or submission of a binding and unconditional declaration by the insurer when placing the order to conclude the liability insurance with the required coverage amounts.

3.) In addition, the following legal and economic information/statements must be provided:

- General information on the applicant (name, address, legal form, representative) or the applicant community (if applicable)
- Economic link with other companies
- Subcontracting information (if applicable)
- Non-existence of reasons for exclusion in accordance with §§ 123 and 124 GWB or declaration on self-cleaning measures
